CREATE USER nombre_usuario WITH password '123456';
```

```
DROP USER nombre_usuario;
```

```
ALTER USER usertochange WITH password 'new_passwd';
```

```
ALTER USER mysuper WITH SUPERUSER;  
ALTER USER mysuper WITH SUPERUSER CREATEDB CREATEROLE INHERIT LOGIN REPLICATION;
```

```
CREATE DATABASE nombre_db WITH OWNER nombre_usuario;
```

```
DROP DATABASE nombre_db;
```

```
ALTER DATABASE database_name OWNER TO new_owner;
```

SELECT pg_size_pretty(pg_database_size('dbname'));
```

TRUNCATE TABLE TABLE RESTART IDENTITY;

COPY (SELECT * FROM tablename) TO '/home/tablename.csv' WITH DELIMITER '|';
```
