Cuando estás copiando y el fichero guarda la fecha original de creación, pero quieres ver la fecha de último acceso

```
ls -lu --time=ctime
```

- --time=atime
- --time=birth

```
-u - with -lt: sort by, and show, access time;  
- with -l: show access time and sort by name;  
- otherwise: sort by access time, newest first
```

Valid arguments are:

- 'atime', 'access', 'use'
- 'ctime', 'status'
- 'birth', 'creation'
